

Adoption FAQs

How much does it cost to adopt a dog from PNWCDR?

Our adoption fees can be found at <u>pnwcdr.org/adopt</u>. The adoption fee helps defer the cost of transport, spay/neuter, microchips, vaccines, exams, medications, food & other necessary supplies. We are a volunteer-powered & donation-funded 501c3 non-profit.

What's included with the adoption fees?

One vaccinated, microchipped and neutered/spayed bundle of cattle dog joy. Visit any MudBay pet supply store and tell them you adopted from PNWCDR to receive goodies and discounts! We work with local trainers who offer discounts to our rescue dogs as well.

Can I adopt from you if I don't live in Washington State?

While we encourage applicants from all over the Northwest, we give priority to in-state adopters.

I'm in love with a dog I saw on your website! Can you hold him for me?

Sorry, we can't.

Can you deliver a dog to British Columbia?

Depending on the circumstance, it may work out for us to bring the dog during the home check. But for the initial meet and greet, please plan on traveling to the foster home.

Can I foster-to-adopt?

While we do get the occasional "foster fail" 😌 foster-to-adopt is not something that we facilitate. We put a lot of effort into training and supporting our foster homes, so we don't want to lose them! All of our adoption contracts include a 10-day trial period. If it's not a match and you contact us within 10 days, we will return your adoption fee.

I submitted an application I haven't heard from anyone. What gives?
